Our understanding is that this equipment will be delivered to Washoe County in northern Nevada for use by law enforcement entities in that county. This brings to close years of VHRU service to the State and local police agencies.

The only Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) we still have in effect is with, the Fort Mojave Indian Nation. We have asked for a meeting in Laughlin with the Nations representatives from their Emergency Management Unit to discuss any future involvement. We will update all at our next general meeting.

At this time I want to make a special presentation to one of our members for his dedication and commitment over the years to the VHRU.

The Board has discussed hosting a holiday party for the VHRU members and

spouses'. It was agreed to host a sit down dinner at the Railroad Pass Hotel in the ballroom on Saturday, December 17, 2016 at 6 pm. VHRU members (in good

standing) will attend at no cost. See below, if you bring a spouse or significant other. Each attendee will receive one ticket for a drink, at no cost (beer, wine only). We will have tables of 8 for those who may wish to get a few members together and reserve you own table.

How this will work

Elite Security holds an annual appreciation dinner for all Elite Members, at no cost to them. Many of the Elite Members are VHRU members.
