## **VOLUNTEER HOMELAND RESERVE UNIT (VHRU) GENERAL MEMBERSHIP MEETING- AUGUST 2, 2012**

- Call the meeting to order.
- Please stand for the Pledge of Allegiance.
- Our Treasurer Frank Bruton is away on vacation. I will give his report this evening on the status of our Treasury.
- Our member in good standing Judith- Hilt Dyson passed away back in May. I was a little disappointed on our turnout to pay our respects. There were only 4 VHRU members at the service. It would have been great thing for her family to see more VHRU members present. Visit our web site and click on the Honor Role bar to see all our members who have passed away.
- Tonight the Board of the VHRU wish to make a presentation to our long time member Robert Boerner, Robert was a local member of the Laughlin Team when he joined. He took over the Team Leader position after Mel Ramos passed away a few years ago. Robert has been instrumental in expanding the VHRU in Laughlin and creating the Mohave County Arizona team as our Tri-State Coordinator. Bob please come up to the podium. I would like to present this plaque and read the inscription to our members tonight.
- The State of Nevada has approved our renewal of the Amber Light Permit. These permits are issued to the Core Leaders only in the event we need Amber lights at a call out. We have 10 Amber Lights in inventory in our Communication Trailer that can be issued to members responding along with a copy of the permit, if needed.
- The City of North Las Vegas Police Department contacted me to set up a meeting to discuss the VHRU assisting their agency at a July 3<sup>rd</sup> Jubilee Celebration.

I met with Lieutenant Sayler who has the responsibility to provide security for this yearly event. The VHRU did assist last year with a limited number of volunteers, at their request. Twelve (12) members offered to help in 2011. This year, the North Las Vegas PD has asked for 24 volunteers or as many volunteers as possible to assist. The City is in financial trouble and funding for coverage at this event is limited. The Lieutenant did say that it is difficult now to get Officers to volunteer, this is why the need for more members to help.

An e-mail was sent out to all members and we did get a good showing, thirty four (34) volunteers offered to assist. Two members drove from Arizona, one from California, one from Pahrump and two from Mesquite.

Our assignment was mainly traffic control at various intersections. We had ample water and ordered box lunches for all our people. The event ran a little longer that last year and ended around 10 pm. The Lieutenant was very happy with our performance and asked if we could help again next year.

The Newsletter, "Year in Review" now has copies of the correspondence from the State and VHRU on our lost of funding and support. This will be viewed by anyone who opens our website.   Arizona sent me information about a retired police officer from the
  Bullhead City PD who is in need of a kidney transplant. A donor was
  found and that person will incur expense to help this officer. A fund
  raiser has been set up to raise fund. On behalf of the Board and our
  membership, I ask Frank Bruton our Treasurer to mail a check for
  \$500.00 to Dan Christian so he can present it at the fund raiser to
